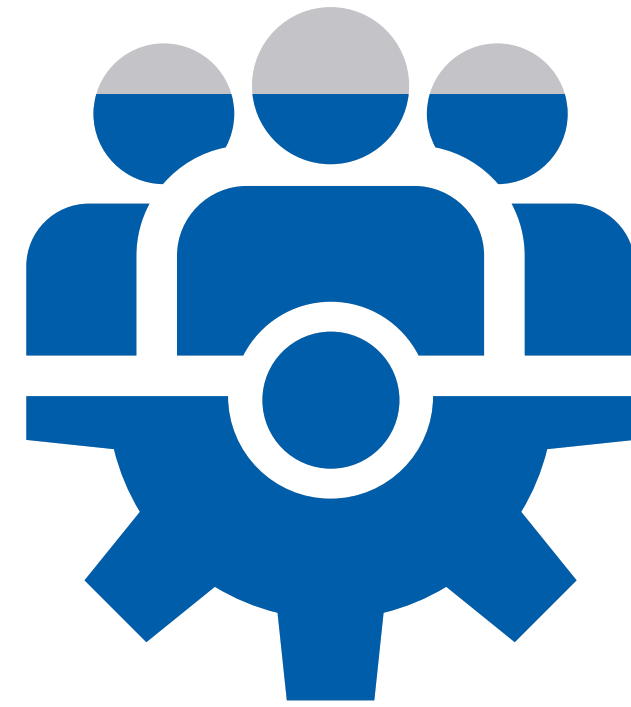


NHS Staff Survey 2023

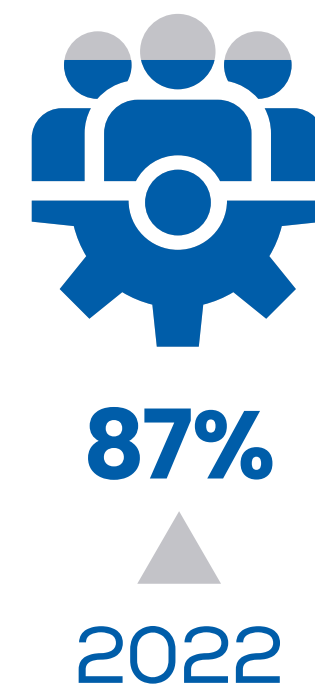

Over **700,000** staff from **268** NHS organisations* took part in the 2023 survey.

Making a difference



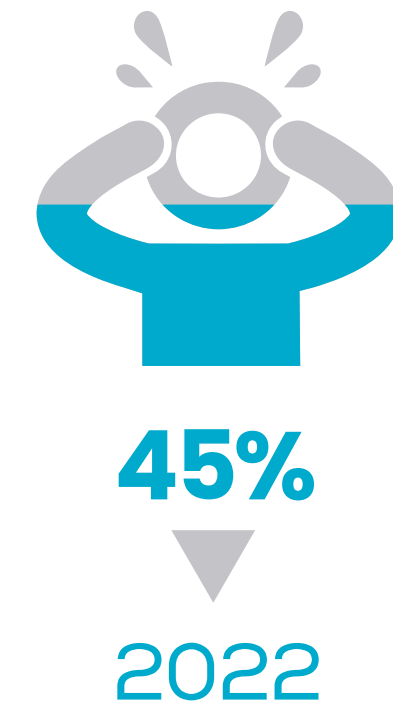
88% of staff feel that their role makes a difference to patients/ service users



Work related stress



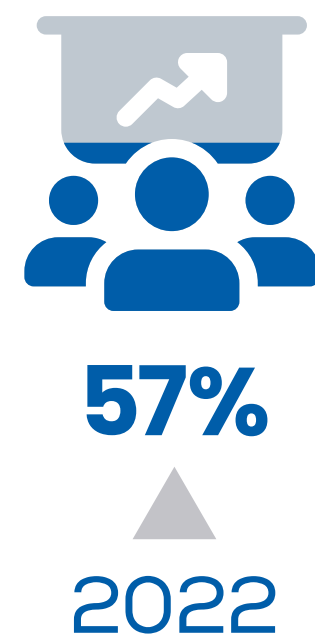
42% of staff have felt unwell as a result of work related stress during the last 12 months



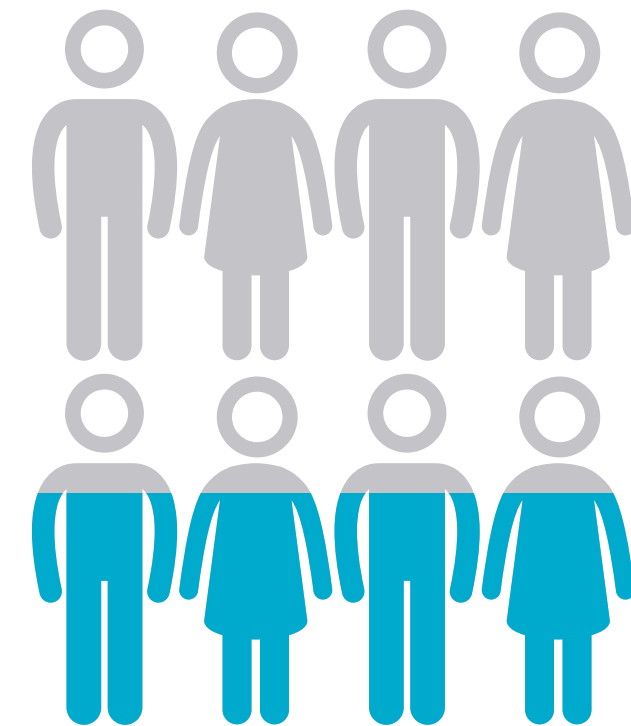
Learning and development



60% of staff are able to access the right learning and development opportunities when they need to



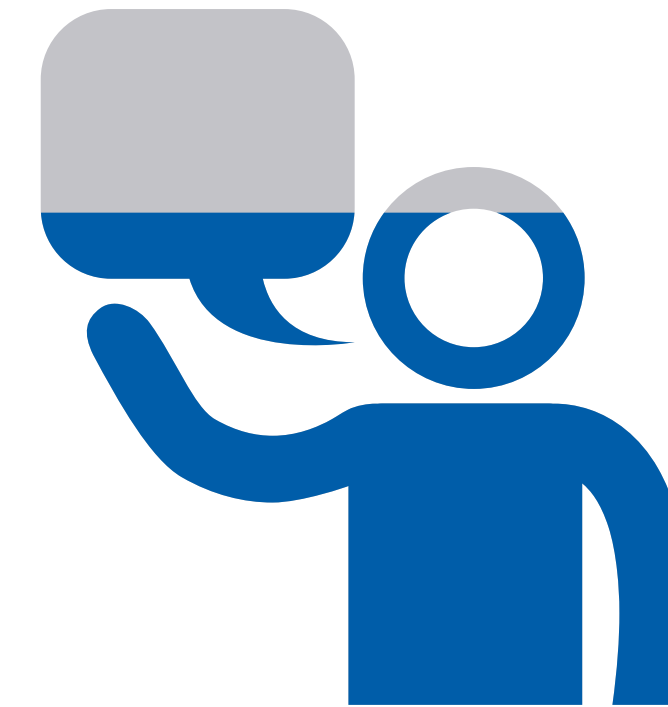
Staffing levels



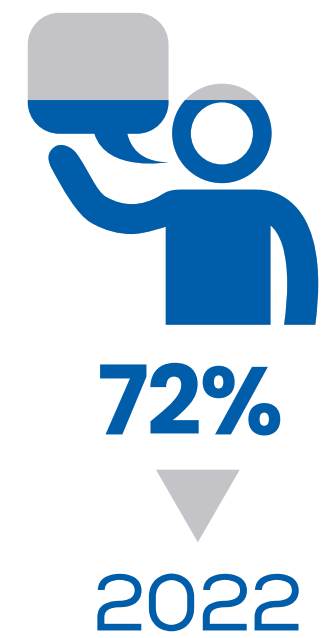
32% of staff said there are enough staff at their organisation for them to do their job properly
