Adult Inpatient Survey (IP24)




This survey seeks feedback on patients' experiences with NHS adult inpatient services. Eligible patients were aged 16 or older, had stayed at least one night in hospital, and were discharged from an NHS Trust in England, during November 2024.



Fieldwork ran from January to April 2025, with responses received from 62,444 patients, resulting in an adjusted response rate of 41%.

said they would have preferred to be admitted to hospital sooner when asked about the length of time they spent on the waiting list. 80%

said they had confidence and trust in the doctors treating them.



34% of patients were involved in decisions about leaving the hospital.



were given enough notice about when they were going to leave the hospital.





rated their experience as very good, marketing a significant increase from both 2022 and 2023.
